

Rules & Regulations:

BBMP SWM Bye-Laws (2020 March)

- 1 The Construction and Demolition Waste (C&D) shall not be mixed with Solid Waste. These shall be handled as per the provisions under the C&D Waste Management Rules 2016.
- 2 It shall be the responsibility of the owner or occupier of premises to store the construction material and C&D waste well within the premises and not encroach or block any public spaces like footpath, road, etc.
- 3 It shall be the responsibility of the owner or occupier of premises to dispose C&D waste at a place designated by BBMP for C&D Waste processing and transport the same as per the collection and transportation system notified by BBMP.
- 4 Occupiers wishing to construct, renovate, repair or dismantle any premises requiring plan approval shall obtain prior sanction for the same from the concerned building plan approval authority.
- 5 Failure to store and/or deliver Construction and Demolition Waste in a segregated manner or dumping of Construction and Demolition Waste Rs 10,000/tonne for 1st offence, Rs 25,000/tonne for 2nd and subsequent offence.

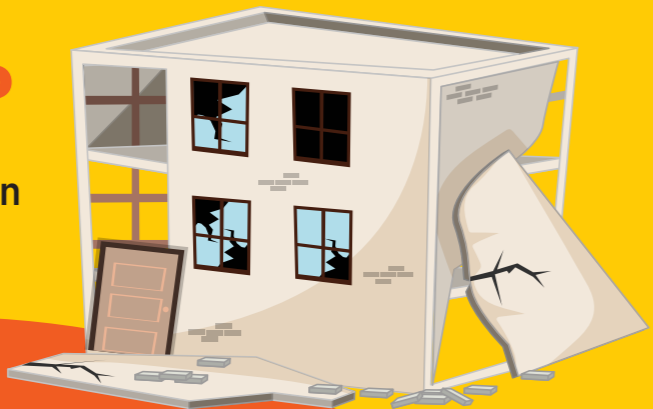

Decreases open spaces



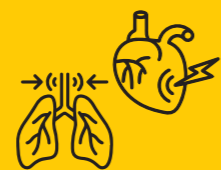
Damages water bodies

Segregate & keep C&D waste as follows:

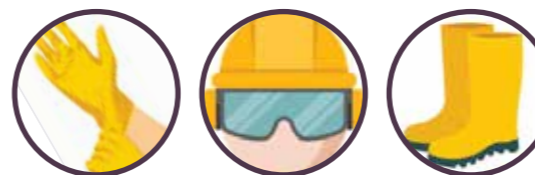
